- · BEFORE USING, READ AND UNDERSTAND ALL LABEL INSTRUCTIONS AND MATERIAL SAFETY DATA SHEETS.
- For technical advice call our LOBA-WAKOL Technical Service at 1-800.230.6456.
- · Do not thin. Do not add water.
- Transfer material to a LOBATOOL coating bucket before applying.
- Optimum processing conditions at +60°F to +80°F (15°C to 25°C), relative humidity 40% to 75%, material temperature +60°F to +80°F (15°C to 25°C).
- Do not apply to surfaces exposed to hot or strong sunlight, as the applied coating may dry too quickly. Do not apply if rain is expected within 3 hours of application.
- If in doubt, create a test area to determine compatibility, adhesion and appearance. The results may vary depending on the type of wood, especially with oily, resinous and chemically pre-treated woods.
- Avoid drops falling on the surface, smooth out any drops directly with a brush.
- **WARNING!** If you scrape, sand or remove old paint from wood floors, you may release lead dust. Follow local and/or federal requirements for lead removal. Application Tool

LOBATOOL oil brush, soft brush.

Coverage

350-400 square feet per 1 gal container. Actual material coverage may vary depending on the type of wood, wood moisture and the weathering condition of the surface. With strongly weathered surfaces, a significantly lower coverage should be expected.

Drying time

· Drying 1 hour. Wait for complete drying

Preparation:

Please refer to the LOBACARE DeckDegrayer technical information for optimal surface pretreatment.

Application:

- Surface must be completely dry before application
- Apply one layer of LOBADUR DeckPrepare.
- Drying 1 hour. Wait for complete drying
- Then apply LOBASOL DeckOil / Color or LOBADUR DeckFinish Color according to the Technical Information.
- To maintain the visual value of the decking, we recommend an annual basic cleaning and recoating of the decking.

Compatibility

When this product is used in combination with other LOBA products the Technical Information of these products must be followed. Always prepare test areas to determine suitability of other products than LOBA.

General guidelines

Cleaning of tools: Clean tools with solvents such as brush cleaner.

Cure Time: The stated drying and cure times are based on ideal conditions (68°F, 50% rH) at the recommended application rates. Recommended conditions are 50°F-80°F/40%-65%rH. Insufficient ventilation, high humidity, lower temperatures can prolong the curing process considerably. Do not use safety covers on floor, do not replace carpets or rugs and also do not clean floors with a damp cloth before the final curing has been reached. Remaining excessive material will prolong curing. On some exotic woods curing time can be extended.

Use of LOBADUR DeckFinish Color without LOBADUR DeckPrepare: While it is possible to use LOBADUR DeckFinish Color without LOBADUR DeckPrepare, the use of LOBADUR DeckPrepare significantly improves the adhesion properties of the finish to the substrate and increases the application safety.

Safety Precautions: Even when working with low or zero-emission products the usual safety measures must be taken. Keep away from children. Do not eat, drink or smoke in working areas. Wear suitable safety gloves. Clean left-overs off of hands. Change soiled clothes.
